Furthermore, the boat ramps at Fort Anahuac Park will be closed from midnight on Thursday, September 14, through 7pm on Sunday, September 17, 2023. This closure is necessary to ensure the safety of all participants and visitors during the event.

Texas Gatorfest, scheduled to take place from September 15 to 17, 2023, promises to be an exciting and memorable experience for attendees. The festival will feature thrilling alligator shows, live music performances, delicious food vendors, and a wide range of family-friendly activities.
